

Coed Volleyball Rules

- 1- Teams can consist of no more than 3 males. Any combination of females may be used.
- 2- A match will consist of 2 games played to 25. Each game will count towards your overall team record. A team may go 2-0, 1-1, or 0-2. After these games are finished, teams must record their record on the record sheet provided by the BRC.
- 3- The serving order shall be an alternation of male and female players or vice versa.
- 4- Back line players will not be allowed to participate in a front line block attempt.
- 5- Contact with the ball during a block shall not constitute playing the ball.
- 6- Substitution will be free substitution at the server's position with the coed requirement that each gender subs for the same gender at the time of gaining service.
- 7- The height of the net will be set at the official men's net height.
- 8- Teams must have a minimum of three players to begin the game. Teams may use players from other teams within the league if your opponent doesn't object.
- 9- This is a self-officiated league so please keep this in mind during game play. It is your team's responsibility to call violations while the ball is on your side of the court.
- 10- In the event of a post-season tournament, players will only be allowed to play for one team. This player must have played 3 games with a designated team before playing with that team in the tournament.
